Collis Rigg and Heater Rigg, Helmsley, North Yorkshire



3 days of orienteering in the heart of the North Yorkshire Moors National Park near the picturesque market town of Helmsley with its medieval castle and Duncombe Park house, the ancestral home of Lord Feversham.

**Location:** The event centre, parking and campsite will be 5km north of Helmsley at grid reference: SE 598892

**Terrain:** A delightful mix of fast runnable working coniferous forest, oak woodland, moorland and rough open land. Previously used for the White Rose in 1992 and 1999.

**Map:** For all events the map scale will be 1:10 000 updated 2005. All maps will be overprinted and bagged. Any special information will be included in the final details.

**Courses:** The Saturday and Sunday events will be to **Regional** standard with limited Colour Coded courses. This year sees a new format on Monday with a Team Score event. There will also be a **Bike O** on the Monday.

**Pre-Entries** (not Colour Coded) are accepted in the following ways:

- On-line entry system available through [www.eborienteers.org.uk](http://www.eborienteers.org.uk) Please note that this cannot be used for Team Score entries and is for the Individual days, E-Card hire, Car Parking & Camping permits.
- Enclosed entry form (photocopies accepted), which includes Team Score entries.

Final details will be posted on the Ebor web site ([www.eborienteers.org.uk](http://www.eborienteers.org.uk)) or can be held at the event centre for you, please request this facility at the time of entry.

**Entries on the Day (EOD):** Badge event maps will be pre-marked and bagged. Entries will be subject to map/course availability. Colour Coded courses are EOD only.

**White Rose Trophies:** Saturday and Sunday constitute separate Badge Events but the two days are combined for the award of White Rose Trophies using competitor's cumulative time for both days. To qualify for White Rose trophies pre-entry or EOD prior to Saturday registration closing time is necessary as are balanced start times. The entry form will allow for a choice of start time on the Saturday, but the Sunday start time will then be allocated to satisfy this requirement. In consequence any demand to alter these pre allocated starts is likely to result in the competitor becoming non competitive for White Rose Trophies.

**Team Score Event:** Instead of the traditional relays, this year, we are trying a new format on the Monday with the intention of making the event more fun and finishing well before 12.00 noon. This will for all except the E class take the form of a Team Score Event in which all three members of the team will start at the same time and will decide who will visit which controls, with the intention of picking up the maximum number of points between them within a period of 1 hour.

Class E for the very youngest juniors will remain in standard relay format rather than a team score competition.
