Dalby Forest District Event (Incorporating the Ryedale District Scout Event) **Sunday 12th November 2006**

Parking: Roadside parking on forestry roads within 500m of the Assembly. Access will be from the Forest Drive at Jingleby Tower GR SE890891. Signing will be from the A170 at Thornton Dale.

Terrain: A mixture of mature deciduous forest and younger replanted coniferous woodland. The area is characterised by long NE / SW spurs and valleys which contain some intricate fine detail and will offer great route choice legs and a number of interesting technical problems.

Map: 1:10000 5m contours, used for the White Rose 2004 now updated.

Courses: White to Brown, graded according to technical difficulty, eg. White = very easy to Brown = very difficult. Pre-marked maps. Please provide your own map bag
String Course for the very young

Entries: On the day only. SI Electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire.
