Dalby Forest District Event (Incorporating the Ryedale District Scout Event) **Sunday 12th November 2006**

FINAL DETAILS

Location: The Assembly Area is situated adjacent to the tarmac forestry road at Grid Ref. SE 879883. Access will be from the Forest Drive at Jingleby Tower Grid Ref. SE 890891. Signing will be from the A170 at Thornton Dale. Please follow the signs along the Forest Drive and do not turn right through Low Dalby village as this is not for public access and passes through the competition area.

There will be no toll charged for orienteers using the Forest Drive. Forest Enterprise has kindly agreed that entry will be free to those attending the event.

Parking: Roadside parking on the tarmac forestry road within 500m of the Assembly.

Terrain: A mixture of mature deciduous forest and younger replanted coniferous woodland. The area is characterised by long NE / SW spurs and valleys which contain some intricate fine detail and will offer great route choice legs and a number of interesting technical problems.

Map: 1:10000 with 5m contours, used for the White Rose 2004 now updated. The maps are pre-marked and slightly larger than A4. Please provide your own map bag.

Start/Finish There will be two starts, both approximately 500 metres from Assembly. Start A for Orange to Brown. Start B for White and Yellow. The Finish is approximately 800 metres from Assembly. The String Course is situated close to Start A.

Courses: White to Brown courses are available together with a String Course for the very young.

Control Descriptions will be provided at Registration.

Entries: On the day only. SI Electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire.

Scouts: All competitors taking part in the Ryedale District Scout Event should report to the Scout Tent before going to Registration. After you have downloaded at the end of your run bring your results printout to the Scout Tent to record your time.

Courses close 14:30

Juniors (under 21): £2.50 (Students must produce valid ID card)
White and Yellow Courses £1.00
SI card hire: Seniors £1.00 Juniors 20p

- Results Please leave one 9 x 6" SAE for printed results. Results will be posted on the Eborienteers website, www.eborienteers.org.uk
- Dogs: On lead in Assembly Area only.
- Safety: Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety; however those travelling alone should leave their car keys and particulars at the 'Information Point'.
- Special care should be taken of cyclists as several forestry cycle routes pass through the competition area. Forest Enterprise has very recently changed 2 cycle routes which only came to our knowledge after the planning had been completed. Unfortunately this means that they now pass through Start B; measures will be taken to segregate competitors and cyclists in this area.
- All courses cross the tarmac forest road. Although traffic is only light care should be taken when crossing. The points where the White and Yellow cross the road will be manned and competitors on those courses should only cross when instructed to do so by the marshals.
- Cagoules and whistles are recommended and may be compulsory in the case of bad weather.
- Cancellation: In the event of cancellation due to bad weather, changes will be posted on the EBOR website or available by ringing the Organiser.
- Refreshments: Ryedale Scouts will be selling hot drinks at the Assembly. The money raised will go towards funding the 3 Ryedale Explorer Scouts who have been selected to be part of the UK Contingent at the World Jamboree in 2007. Two of those are orienteers Simon Percy who is an Ebor member and Chris Knowles who is a regular at the Summer Score League.
