Wykeham Forest, North Yorkshire

3 days of orienteering in North Yorkshire. This year we will be returning to Wykeham an area last used for orienteering 20 years ago

- Location:** The event centre, parking and campsite will be close to the forest and within walking distance of start and finish on all days. The precise location will be advised in final details.
- Terrain:** A mixed forest incorporating a coniferous plantation of varying maturity on the main plateau and deciduous forest with good runnability and interested contour detail on and below a north facing escarpment. The area was last used for a White Rose weekend in 1985 and has not been used for Orienteering at all since 1986.
- Map:** 1:10 000 surveyed 2006 by Acorn Maps. All maps will be overprinted and bagged. Any special information will be included in the final details.
- Courses:** Saturday and Sunday events will be **Regional** events with limited Colour Coded courses. The Team Score event format used for the first time in 2005 will again be used on Bank Holiday Monday. There will also be a **Bike O** on the Monday.

SportIdent Electronic Punching is being used throughout the weekend.

Pre-Entries (not Colour Coded) are accepted in the following ways:

- On-line entry system available through www.eborienteers.org.uk
- Enclosed entry form (photocopies accepted).

Final details will be sent out or can be held at the event centre for you, if you so request at the time of entry. They will also be posted on the Ebor web site (www.eborienteers.org.uk)

Entries on the Day (EOD): Limited EOD will be available for both the Regional Events and the Team Score Event at the late entry rates but as all maps will be pre-marked and bagged EOD numbers will be subject to map availability. Colour Coded courses are EOD only.

White Rose Trophies: Saturday and Sunday constitute separate Regional Events but the two days are combined for the award of White Rose Trophies using competitor's cumulative time for both days. To qualify for White Rose trophies pre-entry or EOD prior to Saturday registration closing time is necessary as are balanced start times. The entry form will allow for a choice of start time on the Saturday, but the Sunday start time will then be allocated to satisfy this requirement. In consequence any demand to alter these pre allocated starts is likely to result in the competitor becoming non competitive for White Rose Trophies.

Regional Event classes: Long and Short courses will be available for all senior age classes. We will also provide Very Short courses for M21 and W21. All Senior Courses will be planned to technical level 5. Junior Courses will be in accordance with the non age class arrangements with courses as follows: JM1, JW1, JM2, JW2, JM3, JW3, JM4, JW4, JM5L, JM5M, JM5S, JW5L and JW5S. Junior Courses will be planned to the technical standards set out in the BOF guidelines.

Badge Event Start Times: Saturday 10:30 - 13:30, Sunday 10:30 - 13:30. Courses will close at 16:00

Team Score Event: Following the very positive response to the 2005 event we will again be offering a Team Score event, on the Monday. On Courses A, B, and C all three members of the team will start at the same time and will decide who will visit which controls, with the intention of picking up the maximum number of points between them within a defined period of time. In Class D, for the very youngest juniors, the runners will still all start together but there will be defined courses for each runner rather than a score competition.

Class A	Open, 120+, All W, at least 1W, Ad hoc
Class B	120+ all W, 160+, Family (2 parents)
Class C	48-, 48- all W, Family (1 parent)
Class D	M/W-12

Courses will be planned to provide controls of the appropriate technical standard for the age classes participating.

The Team Score event is Open - i.e. team members do not have to be from the same club.

Campsite: the campsite and the event centre will be located in the same field. Water supply and toilets will be provided. The campsite will only be available between 16.00 on Friday 25th and 16.00 on Monday 28th. Please do not arrive before or stay after these times. Camping fees are £2.00 per person per night **PLUS** a pitch fee of £2.00 per camping unit i.e tent, caravan or camper van for the weekend.
