Parking: Follow brown signs to the 'Mere' which is south of Scarborough town centre and at the west foot of the Oliver's Mount ridge. The 'Mere' is parallel to and close to the A64 York Road. The 'Mere' is also signposted off the Filey Road, at traffic-lights on the town side of Scarborough Sports Centre. Parking will be along roadsides around the Mere. Orienteering signs will be in place from Queen Margaret's Road at the north end of the Mere, TA 035864. Please follow these signs and then directions given by event officials.

Terrain: Largely deciduous woodland on hillsides, some with little or no vegetation, some with significant bracken, brambles etc. There is also an area of rough pasture hillside which was not on previous orienteering maps. The White and Yellow Courses will use the area round the Mere together with adjoining meadow and woodland.

Map: 1:7500 resurveyed summer 2007.

Courses: White to Brown, graded according to physical and technical difficulty, e.g. White = very easy to Brown = difficult. There will be a string course. Pre-marked maps on waterproof paper. Please provide your own map bag if you require one (A4).

Entries: On the day only. SI Electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire.

Fees: Seniors: £6.50 (£2 reduction on production of a 2007 BOF National membership card or a 2007 BOF Local membership card through a YHOA club).

Dogs: On lead in assembly/parking area only.

Safety: Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety, however those travelling alone should leave their car keys and particulars at the 'Information Point'. Goggles and whistles are recommended and may be compulsory in the case of bad weather.
