- Parking:** GR SE 587299. Signed from Brayton on the outskirts of Selby, where the A19 meets Mill Lane. Follow Mill Lane west for approx  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile and park carefully near the end of the road (dead-end). Don't park in the turning space at the end. Note that this is on the South side of the Barff, not the often-used carpark on the North.
- Terrain:** Irregular network of tracks and paths in a wood around a small hill. Paths can be grassy and overgrown (some patches of nettles and brambles).
