



Heater Rigg Regional Event (Yorkshire Championships 2007)

Sunday 1st April 2007

Final Details

Travel Directions: Parking is at Oscar Park Farm (GR: SE575878). The entrance to the farm is on the B1257 Helmsley to Stokesley road, approximately 6km NW of Helmsley. The entrance will be well signposted from both directions but please take great care. This can be a very busy road at weekends especially with motorbikes. Particular care will be needed when leaving the event. The track up to the parking field is quite narrow and difficult to pass so no vehicle should leave before 12 noon. Please follow the marshalls' instructions for parking. There will be a £1 parking fee/car.

Event Facilities: Parking, on the day registration, enquiries, download, results, prize-giving, toilets, first aid etc will all be located in the same field. Compass Sport will be present. Catering will be done by the local farmer. He will be selling hot and cold food and drinks. Please support our host. If the weather conditions are extreme we may need to move certain facilities closer to or inside some of the farm buildings.

Badge Courses - Entry on the Day: Subject to map availability, courses will be available at a cost of £9.00 for seniors and £5.00 for juniors (Non BOF seniors should add an extra £2.00). Please complete the entry form (handed out at car parking or available at registration) and then take it to Registration with the correct money. E-Card hire is £1.00 for seniors and 20p for juniors. Registration will be open from 10.00am to 12.15pm with starts available from 10.30am to 12.30pm. Courses close at 14.30.

Colour Coded Courses: There will be a White, Yellow and Orange courses available. Maps will be pre-marked. Cost will be £4.50, plus E-Card hire (see above). Registration and Start times as above.

Start: This is approximately 700m from the corner of the field near to Registration. Please allow 10-15 mins. The route follows a Public Right of Way and goes through the farm yard. Please be considerate of other users. Please ask youngsters not to touch any machinery or equipment. Start times have been allocated and are available on the Ebor web site (www.eborienteers.org.uk). White and Yellow course maps will be available in the start lanes before the start line. Although it is a punching start please try to keep to your allocated start time. Any problems with your allocated start times, contact me via e-mail (dennis@dhooton.freeserve.co.uk). Clear stations will be close to the Start. The Finish is very close to the Start. There is plenty of space to use as a clothing dump if the weather is poor. Please provide your own bag and label it clearly.

Finish: Located close to the Start. Water will be located close to the finish. The route back to assembly is the same as the route to the Start. Please remember to Download even if you retire. For any inexperienced orienteer (or even experienced one) remember NOT to punch the Clear station you may see near to the Start.

Terrain: The area is a mix of mainly runnable forest, two valleys cross the area sloping gently to rough open moorland in the north, the longer courses visit the steeper more intricate slope of the escarpment in the west.

Map: By Mike Wimpenny (Acorn Maps) 2005. Used for the White Rose 2005. **They will be printed on waterproof paper and therefore will not be bagged. Depending on conditions sometimes mud can get embedded in the map making it difficult to read intricate details. You may wish to provide yourself with a map bag. See course details for map size.**

String Course: This will be located on the route to the Start/Finish area, approximately 500m from assembly.

Control Descriptions: These will on the map and loose ones will only be available in the start lanes.

Results: Provisional results will be displayed in assembly, near to Download. Later in the day they will be available on the Ebor web site. Any EOD competitors needing results posting, please leave an envelope with 30p inside.

Prize Giving: Weather permitting prize giving will take place for the Yorkshire Champs as soon as results are ready. Probably near to 1.45pm. If the weather prevents the prize giving winners will be contacted through their clubs.

Dogs: On lead at all times and they are not permitted in the wood.

Safety: Leg cover compulsory. Whistles compulsory. Lone runners should leave their car keys at Enquiries. Competitors take part at their own risk. Eborienteers accept no liability for loss or damage to property or persons however caused.

Cancellation: In the event of cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances a notice will be posted on the Ebor web site. Eborienteers reserve the right to retain all or part of the entry fee to cover costs.
