Terrain: Typical Forest enterprise woodland. Good path network. No climb!

Map: 1:10000 5m contours, 2006 survey and map by Matt Crane

Courses: White to Brown, graded according to technical difficulty.
E.g. White = Short, very easy. Brown = Long and technical.
Pre marked, waterproof maps. Bring your own A4 bag if you wish.

Entries: On the day only. SI electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available to hire.
