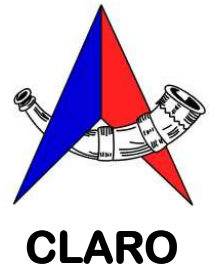

# WARMLY INVITE YOU TO A BANK HOLIDAY WEEKEND OF ORIENTEERING



**3rd-5th MAY 2008**

3 days of orienteering in North Yorkshire featuring a middle distance regional ranking event (including the Future Champions Cup Middle Race Final), a National Event (including the Future Champions Cup Classic Final) and a fun/social score event.

## **Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> May - Gilling Woods (Helmsley)**

**A middle distance Regional Ranking event incorporating the Future Champion Cup Middle Distance Race Final.**

- Location:** Gilling is approximately 20 miles (50 minutes driving time) north of York on the B1363 York to Helmsley road. The event will be signed from the Fairfax Arms in the village of Gilling East. Parking and event assembly will be adjacent to Redcar House (GR SE 588766). There will be a parking fee of £1 per car.
- Terrain:** Working forest, a mixture of coniferous and deciduous, with an extensive network of tracks and paths. The terrain varies - runnable and not so runnable with steep hills and some interesting pitted areas.
- Map:** 1:10 000 resurveyed 2007 by Acorn Maps. All maps will be overprinted and printed on waterproof paper. Any special information will be included in the final details.
- Courses:** Full range of middle distance courses covering all BOF age groups. White Yellow and Orange courses will also be provided.  
Competitors should enter according to their age class and will then be allocated to their appropriate course. As this is a medium distance event there will not be separate long and short courses for seniors or A and B classes for juniors.  
The Future Champions Cup Final will be limited to the top 15 qualifiers for each of the 4 age classes (M18, M20, W18 and W20). Those aspiring to run in the final should enter in the normal way. Non qualifiers from these classes will run prior to the qualifiers from 11.30
- Registration:** 11.00 to 15.00
- Start Times:** 12.00 - 13.00 for FCC Finalists. (non qualifiers from 11.30)  
13.15 - 15.30 for other age groups.

## **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> May - Cawthorne and Keldy (Pickering) (part of the area was used for JK 2006)**

**A National Event which incorporates the Future Champions Cup Classic Race Final.**

- Location:** Cawthorne is located north of Pickering. Vehicles are expected to approach the area through Cropton village and will be signed from A170 at Wrelton west of Pickering. There will be a parking charge of £1 per car
- Terrain:** Mostly runnable mixed woodland, intricate valleys, & escarpment, including a Roman camp and medieval hollow ways. NOT a typical North Yorkshire forest!
- Map:** 1:10 000/1:15 000 surveyed for JK 2006 Day 2 by Stirling Surveys with the addition of the area to the south adjacent to an ancient Roman Camp previously used some 10 years ago surveyed by Roberts Mapping, updated 2008. All maps will be overprinted and printed on waterproof paper. Any special information will be included in the final details.
- Courses:** M/W 10 to 16 A & B -M/W 18 to 75 L & S -M/W 21 N & V Colour coded Orange, Yellow and White  
M/W18 and M/W20 FCC Final which will be limited to the top 15 qualifiers for each of the 4 age classes (M18, M20, W18 and W20). Those aspiring to run in the final should enter in the normal way.
- Registration:** 10.00 - 12.30
- Start Times:** 10:30 - 13:30. FCC Final qualifiers will be allocated start times and will not necessarily be started in accordance with any requested preference.

## Monday 5<sup>th</sup> May - Cod Beck (Osmotherley)

After 2 days of hard racing, finish your holiday weekend of Orienteering with a sociable fun event?

Ebor have kindly invited Claro to organise a Holiday Monday event and in order to enable this to still take place within the North York Moors, CLOK have kindly allowed use of their Cod Beck Area.

So sign up now for the Holiday Monday Mass Start Score event. This will allow you to run around the forest with a fair few more competitors than usual and have a different experience from the normal cross country event. Two "events" will be on offer - one with a one hour time limit, encompassing all the difficult controls and one with a 45 minute time limit with less technically difficult controls.

With an 11:00 start for all, you can guarantee to be finished well in time to have a pleasant picnic with friends and other club members before trekking back off home after an enjoyable weekend.

**Location:** Cod Beck Woods (Grid ref SE474984) near Osmotherley (11 miles north of Thirsk and just east of the A19). Signed from Osmotherley

**Terrain:** Yorkshire Water owned hillside forest on the edge of the North York Moors. Extensive, regular path network, a number of interesting features and a variety of terrain from rough open to thick forest.

**Map:** 1:10000, 5 metres contours

**Courses:** 1 hour long score, technically difficult with harder controls worth more points  
45 minutes short score aimed at juniors and beginners

**Registration:** 09.45 - 10.30

**Start Time:** 11.00 Mass Start

For entries after 13<sup>th</sup> April Seniors £10 Juniors/Students £5  
£2 discount for Senior BOF National or BOF Local YHOA members.

**Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> May:** For entries up to 13<sup>th</sup> April Seniors £12, Juniors/Students £5  
For entries after 13<sup>th</sup> April Seniors £14 Juniors/Students £6  
£2 discount for Senior BOF National or BOF Local YHOA members.

**Monday 5<sup>th</sup> May:** For all pre entries Seniors £7 Juniors/Students £2  
Entry on the day Seniors £8 Juniors/Students £2.50  
£2 discount for Senior BOF National or BOF Local YHOA members.

**SI Card Hire:** Seniors £1.00/day Juniors 20p/day

**Final details:** Will be posted on the Internet. If you require a paper copy please enclose/send a SAE to the Entries Secretary.

**Entries on the Day (EOD):** Available on Saturday subject to map availability for all courses except FCC final,

On Sunday there will be entry on the day only for Colour Coded courses.

**There will be no entry on the day for National Event courses.**

Entry on the Day will be available subject to map availability for the Score Event on Monday.

**Entry Changes:** Any request for refund of entry fees will be entirely at the discretion of Eborienteers or Claro as appropriate, may be subject to an administration charge and cannot be guaranteed. Any changes to entries after 13<sup>th</sup> April will be subject to a change fee of £2 per competitor per day.
