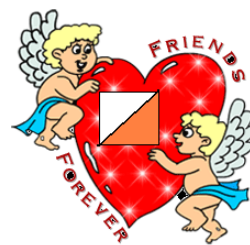




Eborienteers Club

North Keldy (Cold Keld Slack)
on Saturday 7th March 2009



Parking: Turn north off the A170 in Pickering, for the road heading to Newbridge, then follow the signs to Stape. Parking will be on a forestry road West of Stape. Parking grid reference- SE 778 938

Do not try to approach via Keldy Castle.

There will be no exit from the event before 12:00 due to narrow road.

Terrain: Mainly coniferous forest. Several paths/tracks expected to be very wet underfoot as the area is slow to drain. Some forest rides may prove to be very slow following any recent snowfall. Please be prepared.

Map: Map prepared 2008 Stirling Surveys.
Scale 1:10000, 5m contours

Courses: White, Yellow, Orange, Red, Light Green, Green, Blue, Brown. White=Very Easy to Brown=Difficult.

Entries: On the day only. SI Electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire. Start approximately 600m from parking.

Dogs: Strictly on a lead in parking area only and preferably not at all.

Safety: Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety; however those travelling alone should leave their car keys and particulars at the "Information Point". Cagoules and whistles are recommended and may be compulsory in the case of bad weather.
