



# Eborienteers invites you to Heslington East, University of York Saturday 26 January 2019 (Night event, Level C)

**Welcome:** EBOR Orienteering Club invites you to York University's Heslington East campus for a Yorkshire Night League orienteering ranking event. The campus provides a high-quality mix of technical sprint terrain within an expansive open landscape, particularly challenging after nightfall.



**Location:** Assembly is at the [Ron Cooke Hub](#), Heslington East. Nearest postcode is YO10 5GE. Public transport connections are excellent and detailed travel information can be found on the [university's website](#).

**Parking:** Parking is available at Field Lane and Kimberlow Lane car parks which are only accessible via the Grimston Bar Park and Ride junction. A barrier system is in place at the roundabout leading to the car parks. Please take a ticket at this barrier. Parking is free at weekends. On street parking is also available to the north of the campus. [Full details](#).

**Terrain:** The terrain is a mix of modern university accommodation, landscaped planting and fast open with some areas of rough open and immature trees. Metal studded shoes are not suitable and the open areas may be damp under foot.

**Map:** Waterproof paper size A3 and scale 1:5,000. Control descriptions will be on the map and also loose.

**Registration:** from 16.30 to 17.30.

**Starts:** from 17.00 to 18.00. **Courses close at 19.30 and you must report to download even if you retire.**

**Provisional Courses:** Courses will use SportIdent (SI) electronic punching

**Long** 5.5km    **Medium** 3.5km    **Short** 2.2km    and a 1-hour **Accessible Score** Course  
Course lengths subject to controlling.

### **Accessibility:**

A 1 hr score course will be available with controls accessible with buggies, wheelchairs, electric trampers etc. Score maps can be reserved by contacting the Organiser ahead of the event

**Safety:** Although a thorough risk assessment has been conducted by the organiser, orienteering is an adventure sport and you are taking part at your own risk. Participants must take particular care of traffic which may be moving on peripheral minor roads and within the campus. Children must be closely supervised around the lake to the south of the Ron Cooke Hub.

### **Fees (entry on the day only):**

Seniors:                    £7.00 (£9.00 for non-BOF members)

Juniors (under-21): £3.50

Electronic chip hire £1 for Seniors, £0.50 for Juniors. Lost chips will be charged at £30.

**Insurance cover:** If you are not yet a registered member of an orienteering club, you are covered by our insurance for a maximum of 3 events. After this you must register through the British Orienteering Federation.
