**Parking:** At the Park and Ride at Rawcliffe Bar at the junction of the A19 and A1237 (outer ring road) on the NW side of York. (Please do not park cars in the section reserved for camper vans and disabled badge holders)

**Terrain:** Flat open area with a good path network and small areas of young trees.

**Map:** 1:7,500 (no climb) 5m contours.

**Courses:** Schools League Score Event. 20 controls on pre-marked maps. 40 minutes allowed. Maximum points 300 with a 5 point penalty per minute late. All controls on or near tracks, paths and fences. It is recommended that competitors keep to tracks, paths and fences at all times. If you are planning to bring a group to a Summer League Event and have not already notified the League Co-ordinator, Martyn Andrews, then please contact him on 01757 268600 or email [martyn@andrewsfam.demon.co.uk](mailto:martyn@andrewsfam.demon.co.uk) with approximate numbers so that we can prepare sufficient maps.

Senior Score Training Event. Same map as the Schools Event plus 10 additional controls which may need marking up from master maps. These additional controls will be more technically difficult and/or invite routes on a bearing across the open areas. Maximum points 400 with 45 minutes allowed and a 5 point penalty per minute late.

Beginners. This is a good opportunity to have a go at the sport of Orienteering in an informal atmosphere. A compass is not essential but useful to check that you are holding the map correctly. You do not have to be a club member to take part in this event. There will be Club members on hand to explain the basics if you require help. Pin punching will be used at this event and competitors will be issued a control card.

**Entries:** On the day only.

**Fees:** Schools League: £1.00/child      Start Times: 4.00 - 5.00pm  
Others: £2.00/person      Start Times: 4.00 - 6.30pm

Please leave one 9 x 6" SAE if you require printed results.

**Dogs:** On lead in assembly area only.

**Safety:** Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety; however those travelling alone should leave their car keys and particulars at the 'Information Point'.  
Goggles and whistles are recommended and may be compulsory in the case of poor weather.  
Full leg cover is compulsory. No Shorts allowed
