Brayton Barff (near Selby)

Wednesday 13th June 2007

Parking: GR SE 587299. Signed from Brayton on the outskirts of Selby, where the A19 meets Mill Lane. Follow Mill Lane west for approx $\frac{1}{2}$ mile and park carefully near the end of the road (dead-end). Don't park in the turning space at the end. Note that this is on the South side of the Barff, not the oft-used carpark on the North.

Terrain: Irregular network of tracks and paths in a wood around a small hill. Paths can be grassy and overgrown (some patches of nettles and brambles).

Map: 1:5 000 5m contours. Updated summer 2004

Courses: Schools League Score Event: 20 controls on pre-marked maps. 35 minutes allowed. Maximum points 300 with a 5 point penalty per minute late. All controls on forest roads, tracks, paths. It is recommended that competitors keep to roads, tracks and paths at all times.

If you are planning to bring a group to a Summer League Event for the first time, so that enough maps can be prepared please contact the Officials (see below) with approx. numbers (not necessary for schools who have already indicated their numbers on the Schools' Reply Form).

Senior Score Training Event: Same map as the Schools Event plus 10 additional controls which may need marking up from master maps. These additional controls will be more technically difficult and/or invite routes through the more runnable parts of the wood. Maximum points 500 with 45 minutes allowed and a 5 point penalty per minute late.

Beginners: This is a good opportunity to have a go at the sport of Orienteering in an informal atmosphere. A compass is not essential but useful to check that you are holding the map correctly. You do not have to be a club member to take part in this event. There will be Club members on hand to explain the basics if you require help.

Pin punching will be used at this event and competitors will be issued a control card.

Entries: On the day only.

Fees: Schools League: £1.00/pupil Start Times: 4.15 - 5.15pm
Others: £2.00/map Start Times: 4.15 - 6.30pm

Results will be posted on the Eborienteers website, www.eborienteers.org.uk.

Dogs: On lead in assembly area only.

Safety: Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety, however those travelling alone should leave their car keys and particulars at the 'Information Point'.
Cagoules and whistles are recommended and may be compulsory in the case of poor weather.

Cancellation: In the event of cancellation due to bad weather, changes will be posted on the EBOR website or available by ringing one of the Officials.
